On Easter Saturday, April 4, 2026, we will hold an Easter march to demonstrate our peace-loving, anti-fascist, and anti-racist fundamental beliefs.

Time: Easter Saturday, April 4, 2026 at 14:00

We want to communicate the following key points with our protest and take them to the streets.

- Stop the war hysteria
- NO to military service
- Drive war out of warmongers
- No deployment of US missiles in Germany and Europe.
- Withdrawal of all nuclear weapons from all of Europe.

War is increasingly being used "as a continuation of politics by other means." The victims are the soldiers and civilians killed and wounded in Iran, Ukraine, the Gaza Strip, the West Bank, but also in Syria and Lebanon.

Therefore, it is more urgent than ever that peace-loving people in Germany and around the world unite to tell the governments that waging these imperialist wars or support them through media, rhetoric, intelligence, and technology.

STOP, IT IS ENOUGH!

We are deeply concerned that, on the one hand, ever-increasing financial resources are being spent on armaments, while on the other hand, funding for essential public services is being drastically reduced or even completely eliminated. These political developments pose a grave threat to our very existence.

We call on all residents of Strausberg and all people from neighbouring communities to participate in this Easter march.

Our special appeal is directed particularly to the many young people in our region. Take the time. Protest together with us.

To prevent our peaceful Easter march from being discredited, we ask that you refrain from displaying party flags.

Our stewards are instructed to point out violations to demonstrators and to enforce the framework conditions set by the police and the public order office
